THE POW-WOW PROGRAM

AGES 5*–11 YEARS

*students must be entering kindergarten in September 2017

The Pow-Wow program, now in its 24th year, is an innovative, hands-on introduction to violin, piano, music and movement, acting, group singing, and arts and crafts. This program is a unique opportunity for children to experience total immersion in a musical environment. At the end of each session students will perform an operetta arranged for Pow-Wow by the faculty. Younger students who are not quite ready for the full-day program can choose Pow-Wow Prep, an introduction to the activities, skills, and concepts taught in Pow-Wow.

AGES 5-9 YEARS

AGES 5-11 YEARS

MONDAY-FRIDAY, 8:30 AM TO 3:00 PM DAILY

Early release from Pow-Wow is not available.

During the day, the Pow-Wow program includes small group instruction classes. Children are grouped strictly by age and not by musical ability or friendships. However, students with extensive musical experience may be given additional learning and performance opportunities. Please note experience on your application.

CIT (Counselor in Training) PROGRAM

AGES 12–15 YEARS

CIT students help faculty and staff in rehearsals and other activities during the day. They will assist faculty at instrumental and art lessons, and will perform in the Pow-Wow operetta at the end of the session.

CIT students should have three or more years experience playing an instrument.

Enrollment is limited to a maximum of two students per session.

Upon notification of acceptance as a CIT student, full tuition must be received within two weeks.

Registration is considered final with receipt of the \$15 summer registration fee per student and, unless applying for financial aid, receipt of the full Pow-Wow program tuition. Credit card payments (Mastercard, Visa, Discover, AMEX) are accepted as well as checks (made out to "Powers Music School").

All fees and tuition for our day programs are non-refundable. Your signed registration form or online registration indicates acceptance of Powers Music School's policies and procedures.

FINANCIAL AID
